Below 100 – High Level Overview



Mission: Reduce line-of-duty deaths to fewer than 100 per year. (Not seen since 1943.)

Vision: Eliminate preventable line-of-duty police deaths and serious injuries through compelling common-sense training designed to focus on areas under an officer's control.

Values Statement: Honor the fallen by training the living.

Approach: Target areas under an officer's control that are known to result in death or injury.

Focus: Driving, safety equipment, situational awareness and decision making. These areas have been identified by law enforcement experts as being disproportionately responsible for preventable line-of-duty deaths and serious injuries.

Below 100 is comprised of five core tenets:

- Wear your belt.
- Wear your vest.
- Watch your speed.
- O WIN What's Important Now?
- Remember: Complacency Kills!

Primary Delivery Method: In-person presentations of the core Below 100 course and a follow-up Below 100 Train-the-Trainer presentation using dedicated volunteers. Hundreds of classes have been presented to thousands of officers across the country. Trainers cover the real facts of where line-of-duty deaths are occurring and what can be done to address the problem. Below 100 has empowered thousands of officers to take the training back and present it at their departments, their region, even their entire state. Those who attend a Below 100 Trainer session are given full access to all training materials as well as supporting materials such as sample policies.

Support: The International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training (POST agencies across the country) strongly endorses Below 100 as does ALERT International, the Association for Law Enforcement Response Trainers and ILEETA, the International Association of Law Enforcement Educators and Trainers Association. Multiple state chiefs' groups have come out in support. The Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) has incorporated Below 100 in their basic curriculum and the US Border Patrol is presenting Below 100 to their personnel. The Officer Down Memorial Page (ODMP.org), Concerns of Police Survivors (nationalcops.org), Spirit of Blue (spiritofblue.org) and the Police Foundation (policefoundation.org) serve as strategic partners.

Cost: Below 100 is a 501(c)(3) organization and all Below 100 presenters *volunteer their time*. Travel/lodging costs are generally covered through sponsorship, agency funding or some type of grant.
