Focus: Driving, safety equipment, situational awareness and decision making. Below 100 is comprised of five core tenets: Wear your belt; Wear your vest; Watch your speed; WIN – What's important Now?; and Remember: Complacency Kills!

Below 100 works because it focuses on areas under an officer's control and is a common-sense approach to officer safety.
